Your email below has been passed on to me by Leicestershire County Council because I am the UK National Co-ordinator for a European anti-bullying project called 'I am not scared'.

There are project partners in 9 European countries and the idea is to produce a European anti-bullying strategy.

As part of the process each partner has reviewed and uploaded onto the project web site details of 50 anti-bullying resources and 10 x 'Best Practices'.

There are also 10 x 'real life' case studies from each partner with comments on each one from the viewpoint of the bully, the victim, policy makers, head teachers, teachers, parents and counsellors etc.
