The Bullying Intervention Group (BIG) provides training, advice, resources and assessments of the anti-bullying strategies of schools and services for children. Excellence is judged against a set of externally assessed criteria that together provide a coherent Whole School or Service Approach. Judging panels consist of 3 or more skilled people. We are a membership organisation and cover the UK and Ireland at this time. We are former Regional Advisers at the Anti-Bullying Alliance who worked in a government funded programme delivering training and best practice, so we have between us a great deal of experience. Our members review resources, books and DVDs while young people send in innovative ideas. We have a strong youth participation approach and require evidence that schools applying for the award have included the views and activities of their young people. We undertake research and provide members with free online survey tools so that we always have up to date data on bullying behaviour. The most recent book by one of our directors is 'Cyberbullying and e-safety: what educators and other professionals need to know.' This is based on 4 years of data collection and workshops with over 9000 young people.
